We look forward to the opportunity to worship together at our Drive-in Worship service at 9:30 am. We are grateful to have this opportunity to both physically distance and also worship communally, seeing each other safely, while hearing God's word, praying and singing together.

In case of inclement weather, the decision will be made by 8:30 am if the service must be cancelled. Please check your email and Facebook for cancellation information.

Please follow these guidelines to ensure a safe and healthy worship experience for everyone who attends:

- Bulletins will be distributed via email before the service - please print at home or follow along digitally in your car. Hard copies of the bulletin will NOT be distributed on site.
- Please arrive between 9:10 – 9:30am.
- The service will last 30-40 minutes.
- Consider bringing a shade of some kind to block the sun coming in from your car's side window.
- You may also turn on your engine and run your air conditioner if it gets too hot.
- Parking ushers will direct you to a parking space. Cars will be parked in every other parking space.
- There will only be one entrance to the parking lot – all other entrances will be blocked off.
- The attached diagram shows the entrance and parking spot layout.
- Make sure you know how to tune your radio to an FM frequency. Instruction will be provided when you arrive as to the frequency.
- All congregants are to remain in their cars for the entirety of the service.
- If your windows are open and you are singing, please wear a mask.
- Parishioners should not sit in the beds of open-air pick-up trucks.
- The building will be closed so NO bathroom facilities will be available.
- Communion will not be celebrated at this service.
- At the conclusion of the service, your car will be ushered out of the parking lot.
- Offering will be collected at the exits with a receptacle using physical distancing. Our online giving options are also encouraged.
- If you are not feeling well or have been exposed to someone with COVID-19 in the past two weeks, please stay home to keep others safe.
